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### PROCEDURE OF COLLECTION OF MATERIAL

**Step 1-** Result sheet will be posted to you through mail one day before the date of books and notebooks collection date given above, only if all the dues are clear. Please check the section and house allotted to your ward carefully because all the present sections of each class have been reshuffled to equalize the strength as per the choice of the second language; to have equal number of above average, average and weak students in each section; to divide clusters talkative students equally among all the sections. We are sure our decision in this regard will be honored and no request for change of section will be made.

**Step 2-** Collect the Id card of your ward. Ensure that the information given is correct. We have allotted houses to the students of classes 1 to 12 so that the sports uniform may be purchased according to the house colour. Please refer to identity card for the same. Children are expected to attend virtual classes in uniform only.

**Step 3-** Parents are requested to collect the textbook and notebook sets on the dates given above. **The payment for the book sets should be made at the school's office in cash only** before collection of the set. The sets will be handed over to the parents on production of the receipt of payment. The price of the set will be told to the students on their last day of the examination. Any shortfall in the set or damaged books/notebooks must be notified immediately and exchanged. **No request for exchange or return of books/ notebooks will be entertained later. Students without the required books and notebooks will not be allowed to attend classes. No student is permitted to use already marked and checked text or workbooks.**

**Kindly note that textbooks/ notebooks are not to be covered.** Each item provided for the student should be labelled, (name, class, section and roll no. of the child) before it is given for use. Students till class IV should use **HB pencils** for writing. Students of classes V and VI are required to use **fountain pens** for written work, whereas for class VII onwards, it is recommended that they use **fine tipped ball point pens with dark blue ink**. Questions should be written in green color.

Please fill up all the required information on pages 3,5 and 7 of school diary. All the filled in information should be legibly written, correct and latest.

New Academic year for classes LKG, UKG to 9 and 11 will begin from 1<sup>st</sup> April. No child without required books will be permitted to attend classes.
